

## CONVENIENCE SITE RULES

1. Burning or smoldering materials that created a fire hazard are prohibited;
2. Vehicles shall observe all speed limit and directional signs.
3. Children younger than (12) yrs. Of age shall not be allowed outside of vehicles.
4. Solid waste generated outside of Hoke County is prohibited.
5. Loitering is prohibited.
6. Salvaging and scavenging are prohibited unless for the benefit of the county at the direction of the county.
7. Persons delivering waste shall upon request disclose full nature, content and source of all materials delivered.
8. All waste delivered to a convenience site shall be separated into appropriate categories and disposed of in the appropriate receptacles.
9. Persons disposing of unacceptable materials will be required to remove such materials and any cost incurred by the county for the removal shall be recovered from the person disposing of and the persons generating such materials.
10. Hazardous, radioactive, medical, commercial, industrial and institutional waste is prohibited.
11. White goods shall be delivered to the Transfer station and will not be accepted at the convenience sites.
12. No more than (4) scrap tires shall be disposed of at a convenience site per day.
13. No more than (1) scrap battery shall be disposed of at a convenience site per day.
14. No more than one (1) small pick-up truck bed (level) of construction will be accepted, per day, at the convenience sites.
15. A separate 20- yard container will be placed at the convenience sites for large and bulky items such as sofas, recliners, carpet rugs, mattresses or other household furniture.
16. No roofing materials will be accepted at the convenience sites.
17. Recyclable materials shall be piled in appropriate receptacles at the convenience sites.
18. Liquid waste is prohibited.
19. Asbestos is prohibited.
20. Any waste collected for a fee, charge, tax or other compensation is prohibited.
21. Waste not properly covered or secured can be refused.
22. No person shall carry or discharge firearms or explosives on any solid waste facility.
23. Large quantities of household garbage shall be delivered to the Transfer Station at no cost due to limited space at the convenience sites.
24. Sewage, human, or animal waste is forbidden.
25. No animal carcasses will be accepted at convenience sites.
